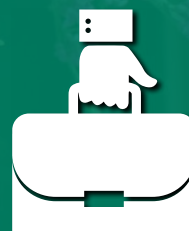

Scholarship Deadlines

MAY 3

Transfer Scholarships

This program awards scholarships to students transferring to NSU for the first time.

Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

Incoming transfer students who received a degree from a community college and are members of Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) are eligible to apply.

AUG. 2

Tribal Heritage Scholarship

Non-resident students that possess a tribal citizenship card, meet regular admission requirements and enroll full time, may be eligible for a non-resident tuition waiver.

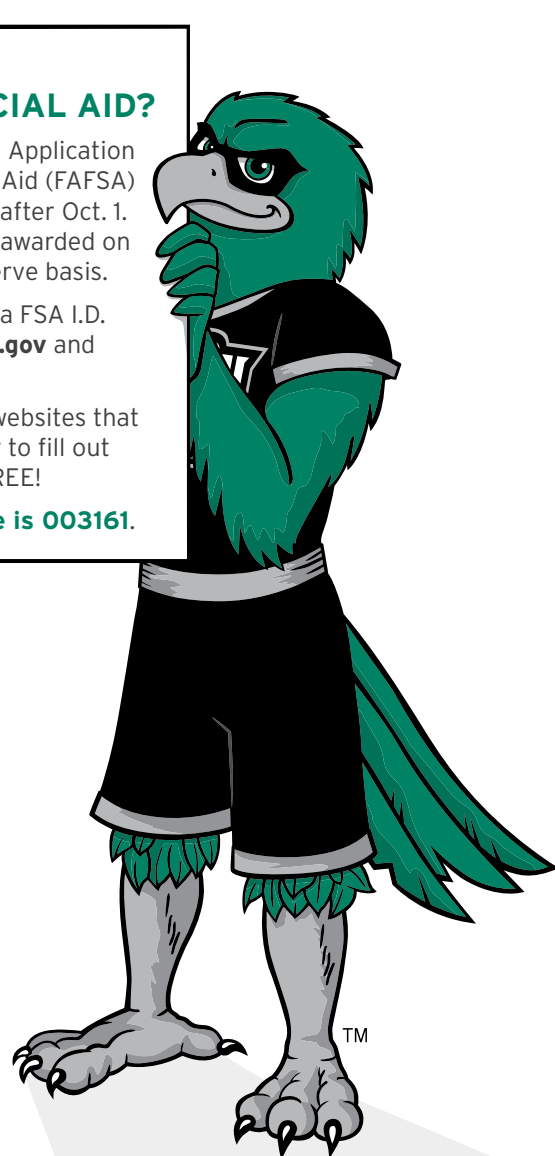
NEED FINANCIAL AID?

Over \$37 million in scholarships, grants and tuition waivers awarded in 2018-2019!

These awards may also be stacked with Oklahoma's Promise funding.

All scholarships are limited in number, therefore students are encouraged to apply on or before the deadline.

Scholarships are not automatic and are awarded based on availability of funds and application receipt date.

Students can only receive one of the tuition waiver scholarships.

LEGACY STUDENTS

A legacy student is an undergraduate or graduate student whose parent or grandparent earned a degree (bachelor's or master's degree) from NSU. Legacy students that meet undergraduate or graduate regular admission requirements (not admitted alternatively, on probation, or conditionally) may qualify to have 100% of their nonresident tuition waived. There is no on-campus residency requirement for Legacy students beyond freshman year, however, it is highly encouraged. Interested students must complete a general scholarship application by Aug. 2, 2021.

TRIBAL HERITAGE

Undergraduate and graduate students that are members of a federally recognized tribe may be eligible for a nonresident tuition waiver. Students that meet undergraduate or graduate regular admission requirements (not admitted alternatively, on probation, or conditionally) may qualify to have 100% of their nonresident tuition waived. Uploading a copy of the student's tribal citizenship card is required. There is no on-campus residency requirement for Tribal Heritage students beyond freshman year, however, it is highly encouraged. Interested students must complete a general scholarship application by Aug. 2, 2021.

The Broken Arrow campus has plenty of quiet spots to get work done and quick access to resources designed to help you succeed:

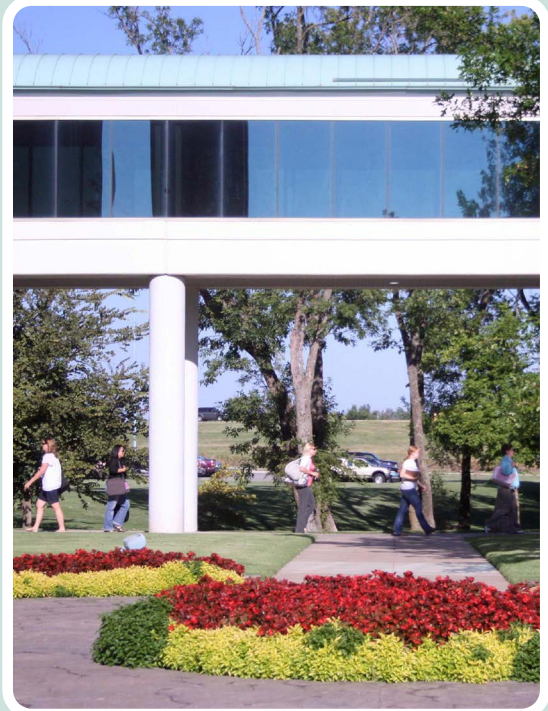
- » **FREE** online tutoring services via **Tutor.com** are available to all students.

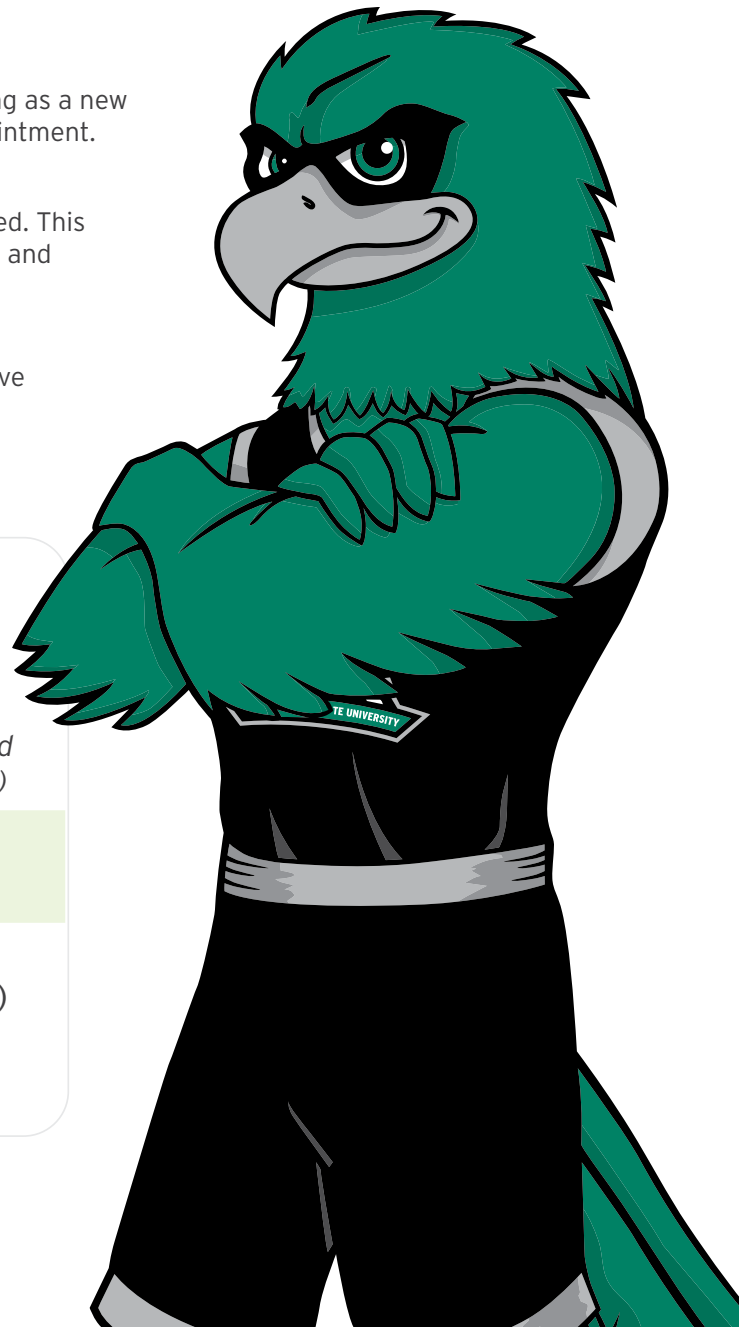
