What topics will we cover in the morning? We want you to have a basic understanding about how the whole college thing works. We will show a brief video about all the student services on campus. What happens after I see an Advisor and get enrolled? You will need to register for an orientation session. To improve on our service, we would also ask that you complete a short survey. After that, you will visit with financial aid, make housing arrangements, get your student ID and pick up your parking permit.
