I. Cover Letter:

Does the letter convey the accomplishments of the individual? Are those accomplishments noteworthy? Does this person show a commitment to research? How does the nominee's research fit into his/her overall role as an NSU faculty member?

II. Philosophy/Research Agenda:

Does the nominee's concept of research foretell significant accomplishment or potential impact on his/her field? Is the person on track as a successful scholar?

III. Curriculum Vita:

Does the CV underline the statements made in Nos. I & II? How do you evaluate the types of publications? Conference presentations? Has this person received research grants?

IV. Writing Samples:

Does this research show originality and clarity of thought? Is the research systematically presented and argued? If appropriate, does the research indicate the use of systematic methods for data/information collections? Do you see this research as having a potential impact on the field?

V. Research with Students (optional):

Did the nominee involve any students in research activities? If so, what is the significance of this involvement for the individual, the student, the discipline, and NSU?

(0 or 1)

VI. Presentation:

Did the nominee reasonably follow the Guidelines for Submission? Did the nominee distinguish and focus on the material that is most important?

(0-2)

VII. Other Factors: These factors should be evaluated equally across each submission:

- (1) factors that evaluator feels need to be examined; and
- (2) intangible factors impacting this person's research.
