Scholarships



Incoming international freshmen, transfer or graduate students who live on campus may be eligible for a scholarship waiving 50% of their nonresident tuition. This program waives only a percentage of the nonresident portion.

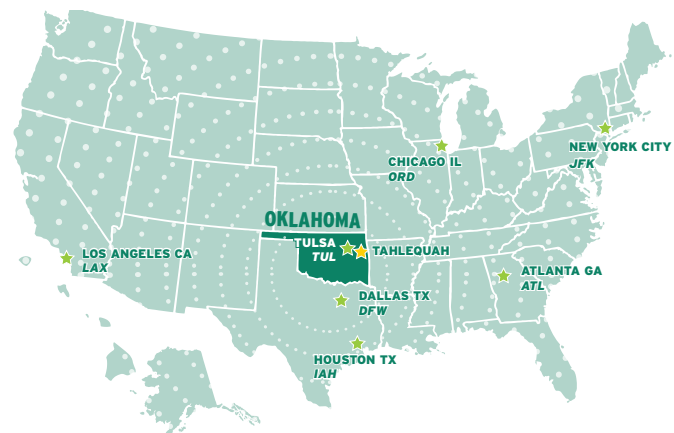

Meal Plans:

A college meal plan is a prepaid account students can use to buy meals on campus with their NSU ID. These meal plans will have a set amount of meals that can be used per week, as well as a certain amount of flex dollars for the semester. Flex Dollars can be used to purchase food at any of our food service venues on either the Tahlequah or Broken Arrow campuses. These dollars are set up on a debit system so that your student ID works like a debit card.

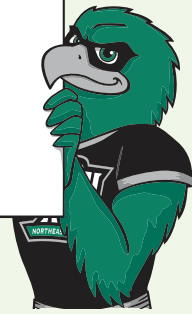
