

Chief Gregory Pyle of the Choctaw Nation and former Chief A.D. Ellis of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation have been two of the strongest advocates for the JOM Programs on a national level. This Scholarship is given in their names to honour their commitment as tribal leaders to ensure the longevity of the JOM programs.



Chief Pyle/Chief Ellis Scholarship Criteria and Application

The National Johnson-O'Malley Association is honored to sponsor this Scholarship in the amount of \$2,500 to a deserving student. The scholarship will be announced at the Annual NJOMA Conference in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Criteria

- 1. Must be a member of a federally recognized tribe (copy of CDIB or tribal citizenship card)
- 2. Chief Pyle/Chief Ellis Scholarship application completed and submitted by deadline.
- 3. A one page typed personal statement on your goals and career choice with an emphasis on how the JOM program affected your school achievements.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation
- 5. If you are a 2012 graduating high school senior you must complete the following:
 - a. Submit a copy of your high school transcripts
 - b. If selected, you must submit your admission letter before scholarship is released
 - c. One of your letters of recommendation must be from your current high school staff
 - d. Planning to attend a two or four year college, university or vocational school
- 6. If you are a current college student, you must complete the following:
 - a. Submit a copy of your college transcripts
 - b. You must have maintained a grade point average of 2.75 or higher for the past semester
 - c. Must currently be attending a two or four year college or university
