MAP-Works (Making Achievement Possible) Scholarship Essay

Deadline: April 13, 2013

Essay Requirement:

Please provide an answer to one of the three essay questions below about your experience with MAP-Works. Essay must be no fewer than 800 and no more than 1,600 words in length, and must be typewritten and double-spaced. Only one entry per student is allowed.

Essays will be judged on both style and content. The MAP-Works scholarship committee will look for writing that is clear, articulate and logically organized. Winning essays must demonstrate the significance MAP-Works had on your college experience.

In order to be eligible for and receive the MAP-Works Scholarship, students must:

- Attend a college/university that is a current MAP-Works partner
- Be enrolled in either the first or second year at their institution
- Have participated in at least one MAP-Works survey during the 2011/12 and 2012/13 school years
- Complete an application cover page
- Submit an essay of no fewer than 800 and no more than 1,600 words addressing one of the following three essay questions:
 - 1) How did MAP-Works affect your college experience?
 - 2) What did you learn from the MAP-Works student report that caused a change in your college behavior?
 - 3) Was there a person who reached out to help you who had information from MAP-Works? How did that person affect you?

*IMPORTANT: Please do not put the name of your institution in your essay.

Completed applications (including cover page and essay) are due no later than April 13, 2013.
