We believe students respond better to instructors closer to their age, so we are looking for a few great leaders to help new freshmen connect to NSU. Peer Instructors will assist in instructing most of the class discussions and will facilitate at the orientation program in August before school begins.

Job Description:

Each University Strategies class will be team-taught by the Peer Instructor and a faculty or staff mentor.

- Peer Instructors must attend the first training session with the Faculty/Staff Instructors on Thursday, April 26th at 3:00 pm.
- Peer Instructors must attend an all day training session for University Strategies on Tuesday, July 31st.
- All Peer Instructors will be required to lead their students during the University Strategies orientation program scheduled for Monday, August 13th and Tuesday, August 14th...the Monday and Tuesday prior to the start of the fall semester.
- The Peer Instructor will attend and team teach the class meetings of the University Strategies class, which meets twice a week for 50 minutes during the entire fall semester.
- The Peer Instructor will assist in the overall facilitation of the course, co-lead the group discussions, monitor the attendance of the students, and respond to student inquiries in the orientation program. You will receive support from an in-class faculty or staff mentor.
- Peer Instructors will be awarded a scholarship, (tuition waiver will be the first option) which will be based on their time invested. The scholarship will be applied for the next semester as payment for their services.
