Applicant Criteria:

1. **Must be currently enrolled at an NSU Smart Choice partner institution (CASC, CSC, EOSC, NEO, TCC)**
2. **Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0**
3. **Must complete admissions application and provide all supporting documents to NSU at the time of submitting scholarship application. Only applicants admitted to NSU will be considered.**

The scholarship will be \$750 for 2 consecutive semesters. Preference will be given to individuals who have completed/earned an Associates of Arts or an Associates of Sciences and have completed a minimum of 45 credit hours.
