**NSU Residual ACT** The Residual ACT is for admission to NSU ONLY and may not be used at any other school. You MUST have applied for admission to NSU to be eligible to take the Residual ACT at this institution. Scores from this test are reported ONLY to NSU. You or your high school will not receive a score report from ACT. No additional score reports can be issued to any other institution or agency. The Athletic Department or NCAA does not accept residual ACT scores. *You may only take the Residual ACT Once for admission purposes.* **Offered: Tahlequah Only** 

**Miller Analogies Test** The MAT is a high-level test of analytical ability that requires the solution of problems stated as analogies. The MAT consists of 120 partial analogies that are to be completed in 60 minutes. The test measures your ability to recognize relationships between ideas, your fluency in the English language, and your general knowledge of the humanities, natural sciences, mathematics, and social sciences. Please be prepared to provide your Social Security Number for this exam. **Offered: Tahlequah and Broken Arrow** 

**Computer Proficiency** If you fail to meet Computer Proficiency at NSU in the traditional way by passing CS/IS 1003, Computers in Modern Society, you may petition to satisfy the requirements by making the appropriate score on the Computer Proficiency exam. *You have ONLY one attempt at successfully completing the Computer Proficiency exam.* **Offered: Tahlequah and Broken Arrow** 

**English Proficiency** If you fail to meet NSU's English Proficiency requirement by making a "C" or better in *both ENGL* 1113 & ENGL 1213, the requirement can be met by one of three options:

- 1. Repeat English 1113 or English 1213 with a grade of "C" or better.
- 2. CLEP Test (see requirements on Testing Services page under CLEP)
- 3. Accuplacer Writeplacer essay
  The Writeplacer can only be taken *after* you have completed ENGL 1113 and ENGL 1213 but were unsuccessful with a grade of "D" or "F". You have *ONLY one attempt* at successfully completing the Writeplacer essay.

**CLEP** The CLEP testing fee is \$87.00 payable online at clep.org. There is also a \$20 registration fee payable to NSU. There is a \$15.00 per credit hour fee to have the credits posted to your NSU transcript, once you have earned 12 hours credit at NSU. **Offered: Tahlequah Only** 

**College Composition Modular** is the exam that NSU accepts for ENGL credit.

You must score 50 on the multiple-choice section to be eligible to take the Accuplacer essay, which determines if credit will be awarded for ENGL 1113 or for ENGL 1213. *The essay is typed on and graded by the computer*.

**Departmental Exams** The departmental exams require a \$5.00 per credit hour registration fee (per exam) payable to NSU. There is a \$15.00 per credit hour fee to have the credits posted to your NSU transcript, once you have earned 12 hours credit at NSU. You have ONLY one attempt at successfully completing a departmental exam.

WritePlacer (Written Essay) The WritePlacer is currently only required for students seeking admission into the School Administration M.Ed. program. The WritePlacer test measures your ability to write effectively, which is critical to academic success. Your writing sample will be scored on the basis of how effectively it communicates a whole message to the readers for the stated purpose. Your score is based on your ability to express, organize and support your opinions and ideas, not the position you take on the essay topic.
