- 4. Transfer or continuing college students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0

- 2. A one-page typed personal statement
- 3. A copy of certificate of degree of Indian blood (CDIB) card and/or a copy of Cherokee tribal enrollment card (front and back of blue card)
- 4. Official current transcript
- 5. Two letters of recommendation (turn in with application).
- 6. Completed application form
- 7. Trail of Tears Cover Page (attached to front of application materials)
