Room Changes:

Located in the basement of the University Center, the Drop Zone is the hub of all mail service on campus. A limited number of PO boxes are available for rent. All items mailed to a resident may be picked up Monday-Fridays 8am-5pm, excluding weekends and holidays.

Internet & Cable Connections:

Each residence hall room has an Ethernet jack for the residents to share for a direct connection to the NSU network (cable not provided). Wi-Fi is also available in each hall or suite as well as many lounges and lobbies in the halls. Assistance is available through the department of Information Technology Services.
