GAMMA BETA CHAPTER GRANT-IN-AID

<u>Purpose</u>

To provide a Grant-in-Aid to a deserving Northeastern State University-Tahlequah undergraduate student pursuing a career as a school teacher.

Award Component

♦ Gamma Beta Chapter Grant-in-Aid \$500 + certificate

Selection will be made by the Gamma Beta Chapter-Tahlequah Grant Committee of Delta Kappa Gamma Society International.

Grant Eligibility Criteria

An applicant for the above-mentioned grant:

- 1. Must be a full-time, undergraduate student at Northeastern State University in Tahlequah, OK preparing for a career in education.
- 2. Must be approved for school intern teaching for the fall of 2016 (2016)
- 3. Must have completed 90 hours or more.
- 4. Must have a GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 grading scale.

Grant Application Requirements

These criteria must be met by those students who apply for the Gamma Beta Chapter Grant-in-Aid. Students are required to:

- 1. Complete the application form neatly.
- 2. Include the following with the application form:
 - (a) A letter from the Northeastern Intern Teaching Office indicating admittance to school intern teaching
 - (b) A letter of recommendation from a current/past instructor

 The letter should address your academic ability and reasons why
 you should be awarded this grant.
 - (c) The letters should be enclosed with the application, each in a separate envelope that has been sealed and signed by the recommender.
 - (d) A two-page, typed, double-spaced personal essay:
 - ♦ containing biographical (background) information
 - explaining why you plan to be a school teacher
 - (e) Current official transcript
- 3. If you receive the Gamma Beta Chapter Grant-in-Aid it is requested that, if possible, you attend the Gamma Beta Chapter meeting and read your personal essay on April 12, 2016. Further details will be provided.
- 4. If you receive the Gamma Beta Chapter Grant-in-Aid, you must complete the semester of intern teaching or you must return the entire award.
- 5. **Deadline is:** MARCH 25, 2016 by 5:00 P.M.

 Late or incomplete application packets will not be considered. The recipient of the Gamma Beta Chapter Grant-in-Aid will be notified by April 4, 2016.
