Information for Financial Aid Recipients Who Withdraw

Upon your withdrawal, NSU Student Financial Services will be performing a calculation (required by federal regulation) to determine if you will be required to repay any of the financial aid received for the term.

Under NSU's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy (SAP), financial aid recipients must meet requirements to remain eligible for financial aid. Please review this policy on NSU's Student Services website.

If you borrowed through the Direct Subsidized Loan, the Direct Unsubsidized Loan, or the Direct PLUS Loan program while enrolled at NSU, the date of your withdrawal will be reported to Direct Loans. Six months after your withdrawal date, you will be required to begin making payments on your student loans.
