- Request Transcript by Mail Go to www.irs.gov, under "Get a Tax Transcript", select "Request by Mail". Make sure to request your IRS Tax Return Transcript and NOT the Account Transcript.
- Request Transcript Online Go to www.irs.gov, under "Get Your Tax Record", select "Request Online", Make sure to request your Tax Return Transcript and NOT the Account Transcript.
- ✓ <u>Automated Telephone Request</u> 1-800-908-9946. Request your Tax Return Transcript.
- Paper Request Form Go to www.irs.gov. Enter 4506-T in search box. Print the form, fill out completely, and submit directly to the IRS (requested transcript will be mailed to the filing address of record with the IRS)

- Please provide a copy of your W-2(s). If you do not have a copy, you may request your wage and income transcript from <u>www.irs.gov</u>
