- **Your exhibit must be in compliance with the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990, Public Law 101-644. Under this act, it is illegal to offer or display for sale, or sell an art or craft product in a manner that falsely suggests it is Indian-produced, or the product of a particular Indian or Indian tribe or Indian arts and crafts organization in the United States. Under the act, Indian is defined as a member of a state or federally recognized tribe, or a certified Indian artisan.**

I agree to comply with the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990, and to abide by the terms and policies of Northeastern State University, as well as the guidelines of the Symposium on the American Indian.
