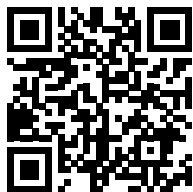

Your Rights and Options under Title IX:

- *You have the right to choose whether or not to participate in the Title IX process.*
- *You have the right to an advisor of your choice.*
- *You have the right to supportive measures with or without the pursuit of a formal complaint.*
- *You have the right to withdraw from the Title IX process at any point in time.*

Supportive Measures Available to You:

- *Academic Changes/ Alterations*
- *Absence Notifications*
- *Housing Changes/ Alterations*
- *Work Assignment Changes/ Alterations*
- *Mutual Non-Communication Agreement*
- *Physical and/or Mental Health Referral*
- *Informal Resolution*
- *Formal Investigation*
