RiverHawk Hype is a chance for newly admitted students to tour NSU's facilities and gain more information about their upcoming adventures at NSU.

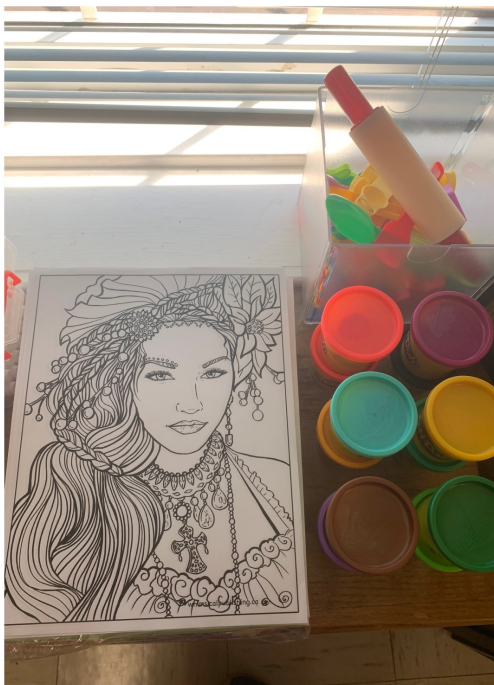




TRIO Requirements


As a TRIO SSS participant, each semester you are required to complete:

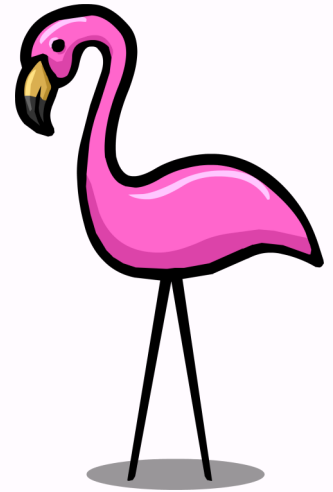
